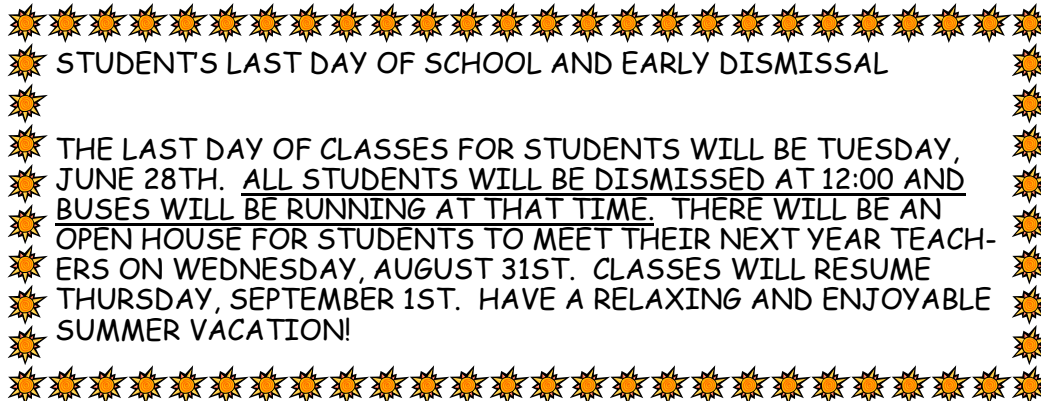

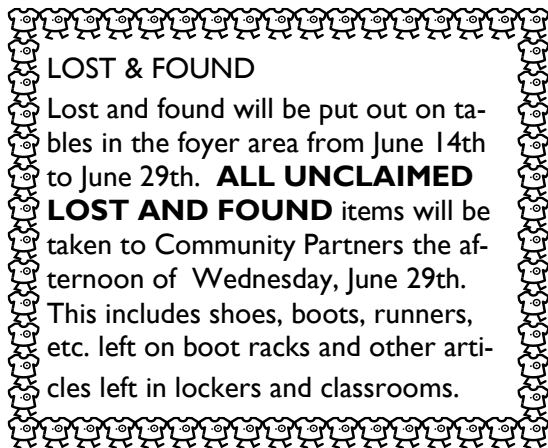

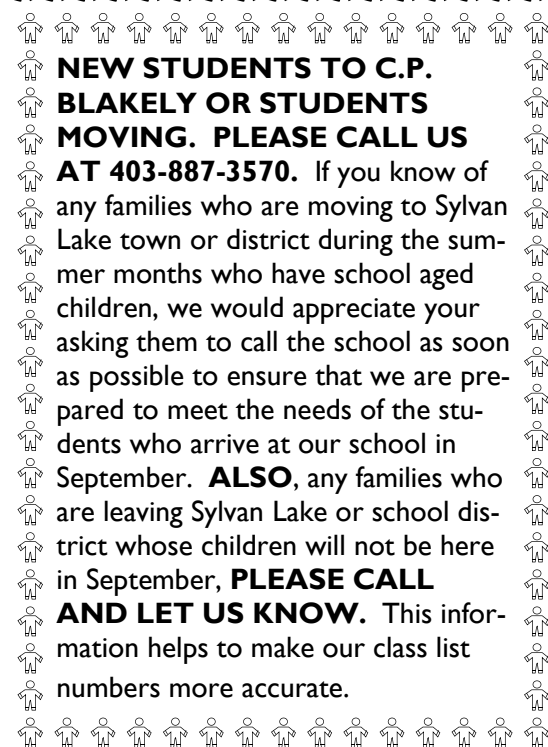
STUDENT'S LAST DAY OF SCHOOL AND EARLY DISMISSAL

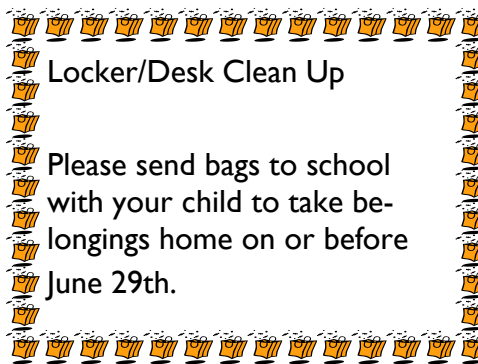


LOST & FOUND

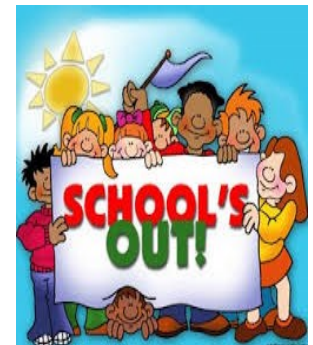


