<u>Respiratory Illness Outbreak Update -</u>

More than 10% of kids are home sick (currently 17%). This will last for two weeks. School is added more cleaning procedures and hand sanitizer. If you are away for an extended period of time please check google classroom.

September and October Events:

- Grade 3's and 4's completed the new "Swim to Survive" program in October and November. Grade 1's and 2's will have swimming lessons in the spring.

-we hosted a book fair, parent teacher interviews, new progress report format - Interviews were held in person or as Google Meet at Parent Request. Appointments for PTIs were booked online through our school website. Info was sent in our CP Blakely Weekly News.

-New Curriculum - Our K-3 teachers have been taking time to really dig into the new Language Arts and Math curriculum and to write the **new report cards** that align with the new curriculum

All teachers are adapting to the new Phys-ed and Wellness Curriculum (financial literacy) combining the phys ed and health class together.

Our 4-6 teachers continue to focus on Writing and Math using the HLAT and MIPI data that was gathered. All students in grades 2-6 completed Literacy and math assessments.

New report cards come out in January.

Preventative Programming for Student Mental Health and Wellness

We have 2 Youth Empowerment Coaches working to help staff and students in supporting preventative programming for student mental health and wellness through our YES Program (government funded). Chelsey and Kristy (our Youth Empowerment Coaches) are here on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Current in class programming focus is currently grade 4. Drop in for grade 4 and 5. Also a small group for grades 1 and 2.

We have Student Mentorship from FCSS once a week as well as AHS Community Helpers Program grade %. Our Family School Wellness Worker Lexi Thorvaldson has returned from Maternity leave and is working to support student needs one on one as well as help parents find the community support they need.)ie grief counseling and financial aid)

School Volunteers

We are excited to have volunteer opportunities back in the school this year. If you would like to volunteer in classes, with hot lunch, special activities or field trips you must have an up to date Vulnerable Sector/Criminal Record Check on file. Volunteer opportunities are posted in our CP Blakely Weekly News and in your Remind and Classroom Newsletters from your child's teachers.

We hosted our first in person school wide assembly in September.

Parents were invited in for interviews and Halloween activities so we did not do an October Assembly. We will host our next assembly on Nov. 30.

We will not be hosting virtual assemblies.
